

ESP **DYNO** Test screen 2003/04 Engines C230K, C240 and C320

How do I disable Traction Control completely?

Instruction set

To start, the key must be removed from the ignition.

1) Insert the key and turn to position 1.

Immediately press and hold the trip odometer reset button three times from Odometer Display.



The first screen you will see is the battery voltage. This does not reset the odometer. Below



2) Hit the steering wheel up arrow button on the top left side. Now you will get a readout of the MFD S/W, H/W and PNs in addition to the oil quantity readout and engine number. This list is in order from the top down. Oil quantity and engine info will just have dashes at this time.



3) Two ways you can go from here:

3A) Now put the key into POS 2. You will now get a readout in *qts* of the engine oil and the engine info will appear.



3B) Here you can hit the up arrow button again and get to the ESP function.



Press the lower menu button (it looks like two sheets of paper, the one with the writing in the background behind the blank one)

Press the up arrow button.

Press the "+" sign to disable the Traction System (turn "ON" test mode)

Then you will get malfunctions for ESP, BAS, and ABS are not working. This is normal, but they don't work, so be careful doing this on the road.





To get out of it, set it back to **off** and then turn the car off and back on. Start the engine, the traction system is now disabled. To return to normal, remove the key and restart the engine. The traction control warning should no longer be in the cluster. If it is, shut the engine off and remove the key again. Then insert the key and turn to position 1. Note that the **DYNO** test screen is displayed immediately. Push the "-" button to enable the traction system (turn "OFF" test mode)
